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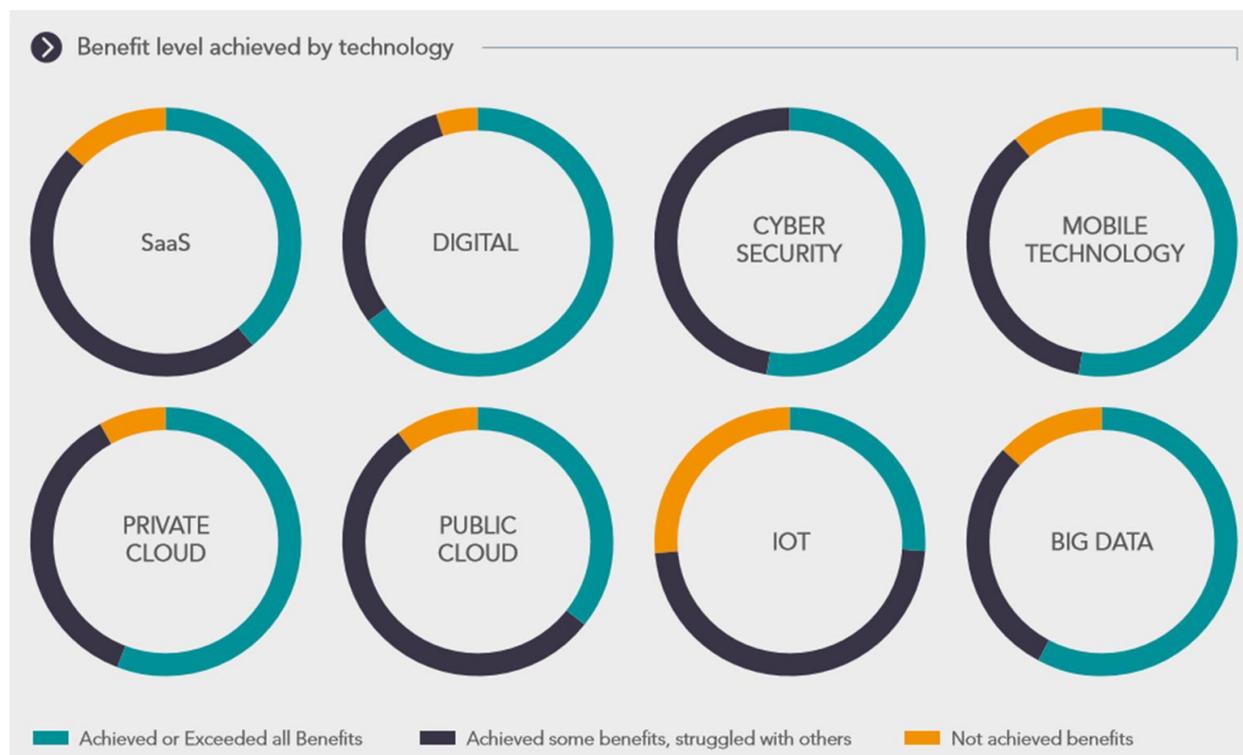

Digital Project of the Year

This category recognises outstanding web delivered projects that have transformed how their organisations do business through customer/consumer contact, brand recognition or projects that have made capability available at the point of need to drive product availability, increased sales or other business benefits. Judges will be looking for innovative approaches or ideas and smart ways of integrating into legacy backend systems.

Winner - Digital Project of the Year – National Trust

The 'My National Trust' project has delivered a responsive and intuitive online self-service platform enabling National Trust members to manage their membership online. Previously this could only be done via phone, email or in writing. Personalisation of content, events and places relevant to anonymous users based on their location and browsing behaviours has also been launched. The imminent delivery of single sign-on across the main website will further deepen the customer engagement by delivering content based on both online and offline behaviours, preferences and favouriting of NT places. The project has delivered foundations for single sign-on across NT's digital products.
